Safe Spaces - Safe yards help kids relieve stress and anxiety when worried about a parent on deployment.



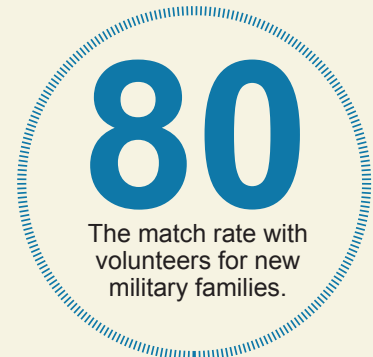
